**Year 4, 5 & 6**

Recap all the letter families in the cursive style to ensure accurate joining.  
Relative size and position. Use of `adapted Little Wandle` mnemonics and (lead on)- *`and off, up, around the astronaut's helmet and down into space.`*

*Capital letter formation* – correct orientation, size and not mixed within words. Number formation.

Recap on all letter joins (see previous years overviews)

Horizontal joins to letters without.
